What is the cost and how do I pay?	Reception, Yr 1 and Yr 2 – free of charge (KS1) Yrs 3-6 Meals costs £2.50. Each family will have a Pantry account to book and pay for meals.	Ensure that you set up a Pantry account when contacted to do so.
How does my child choose their meal?	Using The Pantry's booking system allows the school to ensure your child receives exactly the meal that you have requested.	Look at menu choices with your child and book as required.
My child has an allergy, how will this be managed?	A list of all known allergies has been provided to our provider. The Pantry will block out any food choices that contain your child's allergen so that they cannot be booked. Your child will only be given the meal that you have requested.	Ensure that The Pantry are kept up to date with changes to allergies. The Pantry is happy to work with you to ensure that only the appropriate meal choices can be made available to your child.
What if my child doesn't like the food they have chosen?	Our serving staff and SMSA's have received training in how to encourage children to eat what is on their plate – for example, they will ask the child to eat ¼ of the meal.	
How do I know that my child is eating their lunch?	Our SMSAs currently ensure children eat their lunch. If we have ongoing concerns over your child's intake of food, we will contact you.	Talk to your child about their lunchtime experience rather than ask them what they had for lunch – you are more likely to find out what they did eat by doing this.
What happens when my child is on a school trip?	Packed lunches can be booked through The Pantry in the usual way or you can provide your own packed lunch.
