We have had a lovely week learning all about the Fairy Tales 'The Frog Prince' and 'Beauty and the Beast'. We have drawn our own frogs in the pond and retold the story.



Next week we will be continuing our topic of Fairy Tales and we will be focussing on The Three little Pigs and Little Red Riding Hood. We will be doing lots of fun activities based around these Fairy Tales.

This week we have looked at a different letter each day these are the letters we have looked at so far – SATIPN . Maybe you could practise these with your child at the weekend. Next week we will be learning more letters of the alphabet, C and K. We are using the Jolly Phonics songs and actions, these can be found on YouTube if you want to practice them at home.

Our Numeracy focus next week will be 1 more and 1 less. We will be doing lots of activities related to this, please encourage your children to count up to 10 and practice adding 1 more and taking 1 away from numbers between 1 and 10 at home.

The 'all day' children will be reading the story of The Ugly Duckling and doing lots of activities related to the story.

World Book day - Next Thursday 7th March the School is celebrating World Book day, the children are asked to come to school dressed as a book character, if you are stuck for ideas there are lots on Pinterest.

We will take photos of the children dressed as book characters and post them on Class Dojo. So if you get a chance, please have a look and feel free to leave a comment if you want to.

We will also be making pancakes and trying them on Shrove Tuesday (5th March).

Shoes - could you please ensure the shoes you send your child into school with can be put on their own, we have has an awful lot of shoes that are quite tricky to put on and we are encouraging the children to put their shoes on independently.
