We have had a lovely week learning all about Number Rhymes. This week we have read 'Ten in the Bed', '10 Little Tadpoles', '10 Little Ladybirds', plus a few books the children have bought into School. We have also been singing 'Ten in the Bed', '5 Little Speckled Frogs', '5 Current Buns' and '10 Green Bottles'. We have been making our own number lines, made 5 Little Ducks and completed loads of number related activities.

Next week is National Story Telling week, so we will be reading lots of stories and making up stories of our own.

We will be reading 'The Gruffalo' and 'The Gruffalo's Child' amongst others. We would like the children to bring in their favourite book to share with the class, please make sure they are named so that they can be returned to the right children.

We will also be learning about measurement, using the terms long, longest, short and shortest and in the water the terms full, half-full and empty.
