We have had a lovely week learning all about Pirates, We have listened to the story of 'The Midnight Pirate' and 'Ten little pirates', made lots of pirate crafts such as paper plate pirates, pirate ship pictures and pirate flags. The all day children have been learning all about space and will continue this next week focusing on the story of Aliens Love Underpants.



Next week we will continue to learn about pirates, with lots of craft, collage, role play, boat building and we will read a number of books about pirates including 'Pirate Pete and his parrot' and 'Pirates love underpants'.

In Numeracy we will be counting and adding two groups of objects up to 10.
