

Nursery Newsletter

Friday 23rd May

We have had a lovely week learning all about Wasps, Bees, Ladybirds and Beetles, we have listened to the story of 'The bad tempered ladybird', 'What the ladybird heard' and 'The Bugliest bug'. We also looked at some lovely non-fiction books about Ladybirds and Beetles.



After the half term we will continue our topic of Minibeasts and will be learning about caterpillars and butterflies.

We would like to continue encouraging the children to bring in stories related to our weekly topics as the children have really enjoyed the variety of stories we have been getting.



In Numeracy we will be counting to 10 and working on number recognition, we will also be looking at symmetry. We will also be learning days of the week to link to the book 'The very hungry caterpillar'

Please encourage your children to look at numbers to 10/20 over the half term holiday. Some fun activities could be.....Counting, number hunt, looking at door numbers, page numbers in books and newspapers, numbers are everywhere!

Over the half term please encourage your children to continue to work on the letters SATIPNCKEHR and M, play games, encourage them to paint, draw and write the letters, find things beginning with the letters, play I spy etc.

Summer seems to have arrived please ensure you apply sun cream to your child before they come to Nursery especially if the weather forecast is hot. We will be spending more time outside and there is not much shade in the Nursery garden, **all children** are also encouraged to bring in a water bottle and a sun hat (named please).

Dates for your diaries

Monday 3rd June is a training day and Nursery will not be open.

Tuesday 18th June Nursery induction meeting, there will be no afternoon nursery on this day. (All day children in as normal, Mrs Newing and Mrs Fitzwater will cover)

Wednesday 26th June - Reception Induction meeting for all parents of children joining Glebe Reception classes at 2.00pm.

Tuesday 2nd July Reception Fun Day – all Nursery children to come into school in the morning – there will be no PM nursery on this day. (All day children in as normal, Mrs Newing and Mrs Fitzwater will cover)

Monday 8th July EYFS sports day, all children to come into Nursery in the morning. (Parents are invited to watch) There will be no afternoon nursery on this day. (All day children in as normal)

Sports Day- All the Nursery children will need to wear their team colour on Monday 8th July, if you would like to order your child a sports/P.E. t-shirt (they will need one when they go into Reception) you can do so through 'Schoolmoney'. T-shirts cost £4.00 and come in sizes 3-4yrs and 5-6yrs. The office know what colour house your child is in so you will not need to request colours.

Book bags – quite a few children still have not got a book bag, if you don't have one please order one through 'Schoolmoney' as they will need one for Reception in September, it does make our lives much easier when all the children have a bag to put their art/letters in.

Please ensure you collect your child promptly at the end of the Nursery session at 11.45am and 3.30pm, a number of children are collected late every day, which is often upsetting for the child.
