2. Welcome

Members were welcomed to the meeting.

3. Minutes of the last meeting: The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 30th April 2019 were agreed as an accurate record and signed.

4. Events since last meeting.

The committee discussed the cancellation of the Race Night and felt that an event to include children would be more popular. It was decided that a Quiz Night will be held on Friday 15th November 6:30-9pm. The Secretary agreed to contact John Buckingham about being the quizmaster to deliver questions for both adults and children. There will be a minimum of four and a maximum of ten per team. A bag of lemons will be the prize for the losing team. Food choices were discussed. It was agreed that attendees will pre-select their food choice and will be able to bring their own drinks for a corkage fee.

It was agreed that the Father's Day craft project was a success. It was work intensive, but appreciated.

It was confirmed that the outdoor classroom has been completed and is being utilised.

5. Treasurer's Report

The current bank balance is £3262.40

The Chair announced that FoG have submitted an application to apply for funding from the Co-op Local Community Fund. Additional funding sources were discussed including the HS2 Community and Business Funding Programme. The promotion of Easy Fundraising was discussed.

The Chair explained that each term, there will be a disco, a craft project and an event to help generate and regularise income.

A 50 Club was discussed. It was agreed that FoG would aim to sell fifty numbers for £2 a month (£20 a year). Participants would be entered for ten draws a year and draws would take place each month from October until July. Three numbers would be drawn each month & prizes would be 20%, 10% and 5% of the takings, so each month, the winners would get £20, £10 & £5. It was agreed that promotion would start at the Open Evening on Thursday 4th July.
