Friday 20th September

This week we have enjoyed learning about birthdays and family celebrations, we have sung Happy Birthday and enjoyed playing in the Birthday party home corner. The children have also been showing off their writing skills and been doing lots of topic related craft, some of which is on the walls in Nursery.

Next week we will be continuing to focus on our listening skills, particularly distinguishing between different sounds in the environment. Please encourage your child to talk about what they can hear at home and when you are out and about at the park/supermarket etc. We will continue to talk about the sounds they have heard in and around Nursery. We will also be learning about the number 2 and the square shape.

Our topic next week is the sense of touch, maybe you could encourage your child to bring something in for the feely table. It could be anything, maybe something natural like a stick, conker shell, acorn, or a leaf with an interesting texture to place on our interest table.

As the weather begins to get a bit colder please be aware that the children in Nursery tend to spend quite a bit of time outside, if it looks like it could be chilly/wet please send in a coat and welly boots which are clearly named.

Could I also please remind you that all drinks bottles and snack boxes, coats, jumpers and spare clothes need to be clearly named. This week we have had two jumpers left with no names and snack pots the children can't identify. If your child has more than one coat can you ensure they are all named. All children should also have a pair of named plimsoles in Nursery every day, children should not be wearing outdoor shoes/trainers in Nursery.

Free fruit for school, each child receives a piece of fruit each day, these are set each day, obviously the children have their likes and dislikes so I thought you might appreciate an idea of what fruits are supplied each day. Up until half term the fruit available are: Monday – pear, Tuesday – apple, Wednesday – citrus, Thursday – Banana, Friday – Carrot. Occasionally the fruit is substituted if there is an issue with the suppliers but they are generally the same each week. If you would like to send in fruit for your child please feel free to do so, remembering to label them clearly. All day children are asked to bring in a fruit snack every day that they can have in the morning session. (Grapes need to be cut lengthways as they are a choking hazard)

Cooking Money – Can we please remind you, if you have not already paid, that we require £2 payment for this term's cooking activities.
