


Please, please don't forget to send in family photo's if you haven't already.

Next week in phonics we will continue to focus on our listening skills, particularly distinguishing between different sounds. Please encourage your child to talk about what they can hear at home and when you are out and about at the park/supermarket etc.

We will also be learning about the number 3 and the triangle shape.

Our topic next week will continue with the senses theme and we will be talking about sight and sound, looking at different colours/colour mixing and making our own musical instruments. Can we ask the children to bring in something which makes a sound (not too big) you could even encourage them to make their own shaker/instrument to link with hearing and objects of different colours, these will be placed on our sensory table for the week.



We encourage all of the children to have a bookbag to bring important letters and artwork home, if you have not ordered a bookbag yet, you can send £4 into Nursery in an envelope and we will give your child a bookbag. Can we also remind you to please empty the bags each week and send them back to school on a Monday for us to fill during the week and we will send them home on a Friday.

As the weather begins to get a bit colder please be aware that the children in Nursery tend to spend quite a bit of time outside, please ensure your child is sent in with a coat every day and welly boots (If it's raining) which are clearly named.

Cooking money, if you haven't already sent in your £2 please could you do so next week. We are going to start making cakes, all our recipes are vegetarian and we have notes on allergies that we know about.
