We have had a lovely week learning about our senses of sight and hearing. We have looked at our eyes and that eyes are different colours, we have been listening to sounds around us and talked about why some children have hearing aids or cochlear implants.

The children have loved exploring a range of different musical instruments. Also thank you to those children who bought in instruments from home, we saw some lovely shakers decorated in glitter, beads and feathers.

Next week we will be learning all about our senses of taste and smell.
