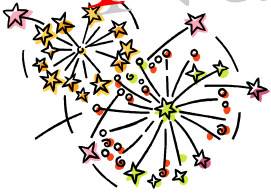


Nursery Newsletter

Welcome back, we hope you all had a lovely half term.

We have had a lovely week learning about Diwali, Halloween, Fireworks night and colour. We have done lots of Halloween and firework inspired art work, we made pumpkin faces, rocket pictures and also used construction to make firework shapes. We also made and decorated diya lamps for Diwali.
