


# Nursery Newsletter

Happy New Year to you all, we hope you had a lovely Christmas break.

We have had a fun few days learning all about Nursery Rhymes. We have been singing lots of rhymes, especially 'Incy Wincy Spider' and 'Hickory Dickory Dock'. The children have done lots of spider related craft and even made a giant spider out of the giant Lego bricks.

Next week our focus will be 'Humpty Dumpty', 'The Grand Old Duke of York' and 'Miss Polly had a dolly'. All day children will be learning about Old McDonald, they will be doing lots of fun activities based on these nursery rhymes.

**Hard boiled eggs** – please can all children bring in a hard-boiled egg next week. We would love it if the children could draw faces on their eggs, we are going to do some experiments involving a wall and a fall! (Please write your child's name on the eggs!)

We are also going to do an eight nursery rhyme challenge over the next few weeks so please practice singing nursery rhymes with your child over the weekend, certificates will be given to those children who can recite eight different nursery rhymes. (Any 8 nursery rhymes)

We will be using the outdoor area regularly and as it is still very cold please ensure your child has a warm coat, hat and scarf in school (all labelled please). Could we also ask that their coats are suitable for messy play as we do have water, paint and chalk in the outdoor area.

**Cooking Money**, we are asking for £2 towards cooking activities for this term, we plan to make lots of lovely things but need your help to buy the ingredients. Please send in money in a named envelope.

Could we please remind you that girls with long hair should have it tied up to prevent the spread of head lice. (There were a few cases last term)

**Water bottles** – We have only been in school for four days and we have already accumulated a number of water bottles and snack pots which are not named and no-one has claimed them. Please, please, please label **everything** you send in to Nursery including coats, jumpers and shoes. Could you also ensure the children only have water in their bottles, no squash etc.

If your child has siblings in the school, they will have their photos taken together. Drop your child at nursery as normal and go to the main school office.
