


# Nursery Newsletter

## Friday 13th March


We have had a lovely week learning all about the fairy tales of 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Little Red Riding Hood'. We have retold the story and have completed some fantastic artwork painted pigs, made their houses and made a little red riding hood collage.

We also read some alternative versions and sang along to Debbie and friends on YouTube. We have been looking at the letters SAT and I.

Please continue to look at these letters at home with your child as well as the numbers 1-10.



Next week we will be continuing our topic of Fairy Tales and we will be focusing on 'Cinderella' and 'The Princess and the Pea'. We will be doing lots of fun activities based around these fairy tales. The 'All day' children will be reading 'Snow White' and learning about the letter E and the octagon shape.



Next week we will be doing body percussion and encouraging the children to copy sounds e.g. claps, clicks and stamping feet.

We will also be looking at the letters P and N, please encourage your child to find something at home beginning with these letters.

Our Numeracy focus next week will continue to be counting, particularly counting a given number from a larger group of objects. We will be doing lots of activities related to this, please encourage your child to count out lots of things at home. We will also be talking about capacity, using the terms – empty, half-full and full, if you could use these terms at home we would really appreciate it – bath time would be a great opportunity to do this!

This week we have been looking at number recognition, please can you encourage your child to look at numbers at home and when you are out and about. We are aiming for all children in Nursery to recognise at least numbers 1-10 by the start of the summer term, if your child can recognise numbers 1-10 consistently then they can work on numbers past 10. There are numbers everywhere, in the supermarket, on doors, on drain covers, car number plates, newspapers, page numbers in books etc. Therefore the children are exposed to them all the time so it's a great way to reinforce their number knowledge.

**Coronavirus – just to let you know, the children have been washing their hands regularly and have had lessons on how to do it properly. We have been singing Happy Birthday twice while they wash their hands and we have sanitiser in all classrooms which we have been using. Please note that children in Nursery are not allowed to bring in their own hand sanitiser. Please look out for the following symptoms, high temperature and a new constant/persistent cough. We will send children home if they display symptoms and they will be required to be off for the 7 day period.**
