

## **Frequently asked questions - Nursery**

### **Can my child attend Nursery part time? E.g. Three days a week.**

Unfortunately, this year as we are so full we cannot offer part time attendance at this time. We currently have a waiting list and we have to be mindful that if we were to offer part time spaces this would take a place from someone who would need to attend five days. We must also consider the curriculum coverage within Nursery as we cover different areas of the curriculum across the week.

### **Can I change from AM to PM Sessions?**

Due to a high number of full time and semi-full time children wishing to attend this year, we are currently full in the afternoons and we are therefore unable to offer afternoon places at this time. Staffing ratios and the amount of spaces we are allowed to fill at any given time within the Nursery have to be strictly adhered to, and swapping sessions would unfortunately affect these ratios.

### **Will the Nursery staff change my child's nappy?**

Yes, we are happy to change nappies or pull-ups if your child is still in the process of being toilet trained; we will however, expect you to supply nappies, wipes and nappy sacks for your child, as we do not provide these. We will also support you in the toilet training process but this is something we expect you the parent to lead on at home, as we are primarily an educational setting and not a private day-care facility.

### **Can my Nursery child attend breakfast/after school clubs?**

Unfortunately, our breakfast and afterschool club providers do not accept children under school age at this time.

### **If my child attends the school nursery, will they automatically get a school place at Glebe in Reception?**

No- the Local Authority is responsible for allocating places within schools; the school has no control over places. You will need to apply following the LA guidelines.

### **Will I get a daily report on what my child has been doing at school?**

We do not provide home school books for children as the children as we found that the staff had to spend the majority of the afternoon writing them up each day, which took away from the learning and support the children were receiving. We do however; encourage you to sign up to Class Dojo and our 2simple profile app where we send home updates on the learning and activities your child has been participating in each week.
