We will stop accepting cleaning product triggers, although they can be recycled through the council's normal household recycling service in Hillingdon.

We have now begun to collect all parts of Babybel packaging. This includes the net, metal clasp, label, wax and packaging for Babybel mini rolls.

Please remember to check our accepted list as we do not accept items such as frozen food bags or any pet food packaging. They can be recycled at supermarkets including the Co-op, Sainsbury's and Tesco.
