Curriculum Review

As it has been 4 years since our last Ofsted inspection and the Ofsted framework has changed since that visit, I invited an Education Consultant into school to assess the quality of our curriculum.

Over the past 3 years we have worked really hard to develop a curriculum that not only excites and engages the children but also provides them with vital skills and knowledge.

The review took place yesterday and was a very stringent assessment which included visiting every lesson during the morning, interviews with all foundation subject leaders, i.e. subjects other than maths and English, interviews with some of the children about their learning and how much they have remembered about their learning in previous years as well as interviews with the members of the Curriculum and Policy committee of our Governing Body.

I have yet to receive the final report but feedback on the day was extremely positive with the assessor saying that our provision is very strong and our subject leaders are knowledgeable and supportive and that the children were delightful – behaviour was exemplary across the school and the children he spoke to had a thirst for learning and were able to answer all of his questions confidently and in a good deal of depth.
