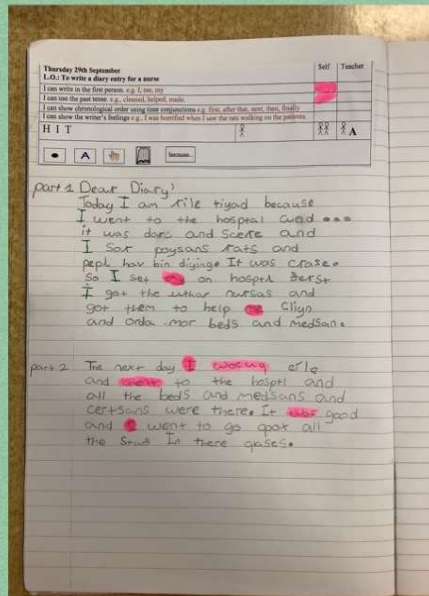
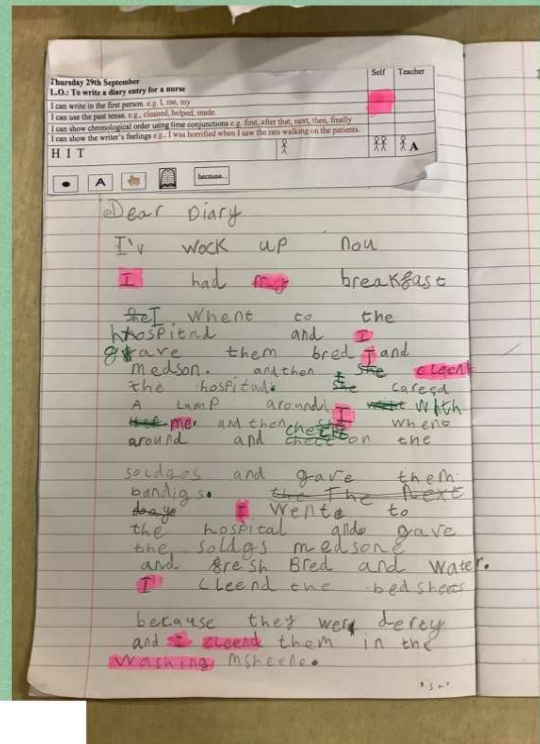
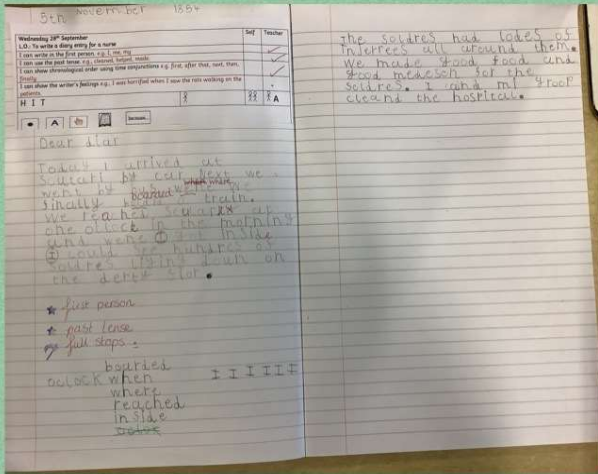
# Year 1

We have been writing verbs about our new story "The Book of Butterflies".

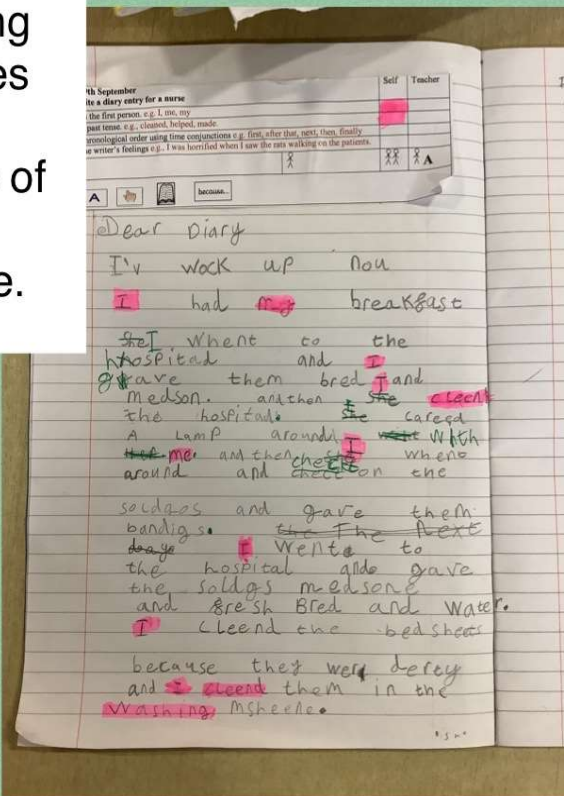
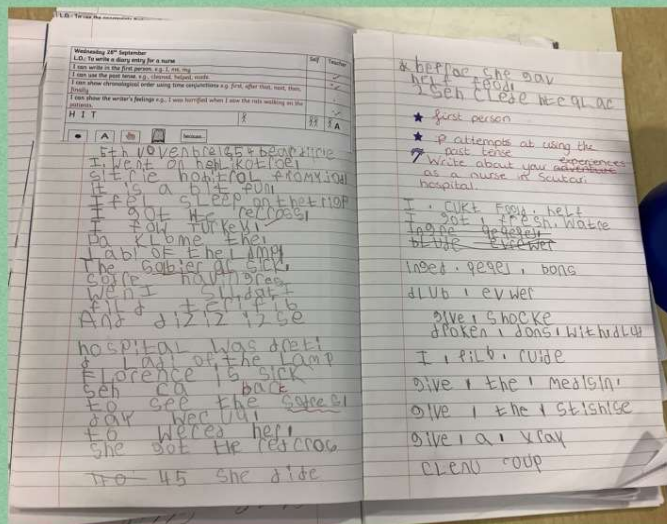




# Year 2
