

The World 30-50

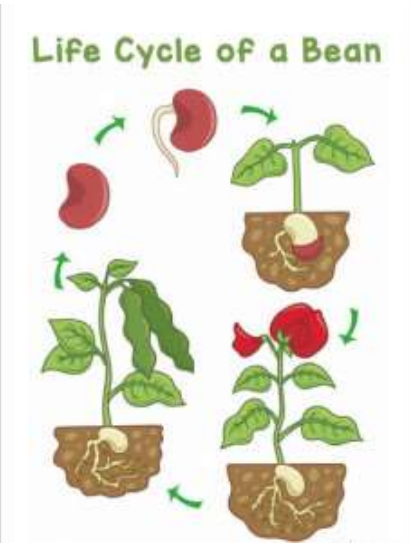
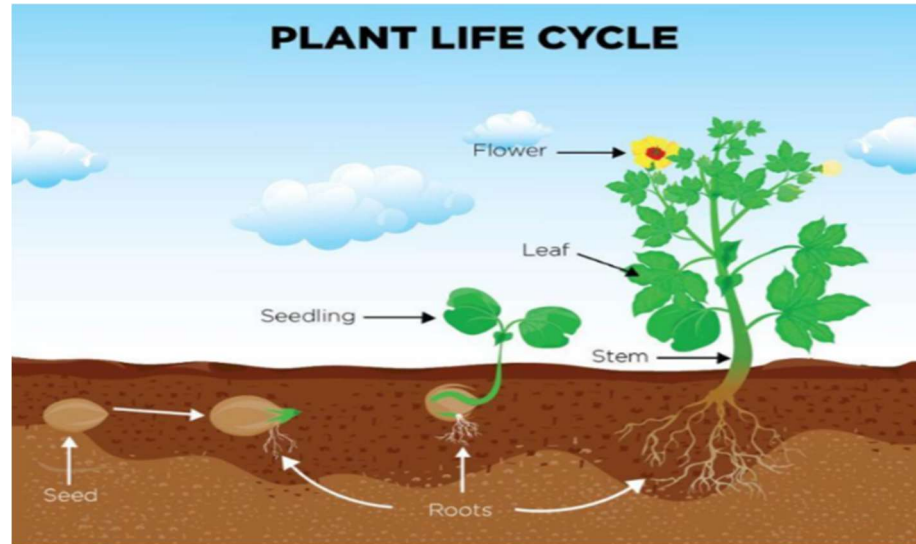
- Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world.

Early learning goal – the world

They make observations of animals and plants and explain why some things occur, and talk about changes.

5 Things Plants Need

How to grow a plant

You will need:
 -Seeds
 -Soil
 -Plant Pot
 -Watering Can

- 1** Fill half your plant pot with soil.
- 2** Sprinkle your seeds onto the soil.
- 3** Pour more soil over the seeds.
- 4** Use the watering can to dampen the soil.
- 5** Set your plant pot by a window for sunlight.
- 6** Water your seeds regularly.
- 7** Soon your plant will start to grow.
