Teacher Strikes

NEU strikes are scheduled to take place on the following dates:

We are currently carrying out risk assessments to minimise the level of disruption to the children's education whilst also ensuring pupil safety.

There are several options available that are currently being considered and once a decision has been made, you will be notified at the earliest opportunity regarding the arrangements for Wednesday 1st February 2023 and provisional plans for the March dates.

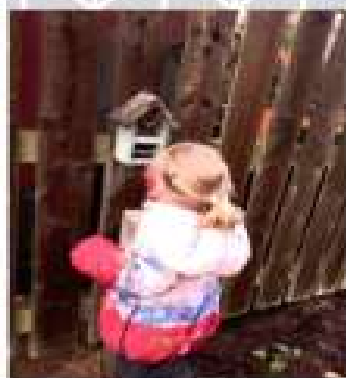

Full time nursery learnt the rhyme Hickory Dickory Dock



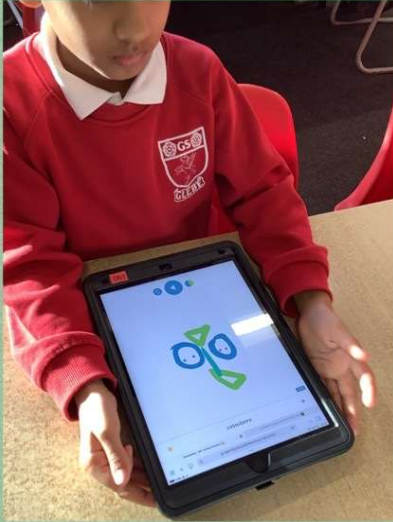
