# Full Time Pastoral Support Worker & Service Family Support Worker

Overview: Regular 1:1 sessions with a specialist adults to support emotional needs, particularly during times of deployment.

Aim/Outcomes: Children feel emotionally supported and their emotional literacy develops. Their self-confidence and happiness improves.

Cost: £12,000 per year

#### Transition In – All About Me

Overview: Children who are new to Glebe have 1:1 or small group sessions to create an *All About Me* book and regular follow up.

Aim/Outcomes: Teacher gets to know how the child learns, their likes and dislikes as well as the family situation so the child can settle as soon as possible.

#### **Lego Therapy**

Overview: Group based sessions used to promote team work, build confidence in small group sessions using Lego building blocks and instructions.

Aim/Outcomes: Children's self-confidence grows as they take on roles of responsibility to achieve a set task. Children develop communication skills, develop emotional understanding and how to behave with others in social situations.

Cost: £1,789.20

## Transition Out – My Passport & Memory Book

Overview: Children who are leaving Glebe have 1:1 or small group sessions to create a Passport to take with them to their new school. Children look at the school they are going to in order to prepare them for the change

Aim/Outcomes: Children who are leaving Glebe have a memento of their time spent with us and their friends write them messages wishing them well.

# Well Being

#### **Seasons for Growth**

Overview: Group support for pupils who have experienced a significant loss or separation in their lives.

Aim/Outcomes: Children feel emotionally supported and able to discuss their loss, identify the emotions associated with loss and move forward emotionally.

Cost: £1,716.20

#### **Military Mates Group**

Overview: A group intervention for pupils from service families to talk about their experiences and to get to know each other.

Aim/Outcomes: Children feel emotionally supported by each other and can relax and have fun with children who have similar life experiences to them.

Cost: £1,716.20

#### **Military Mentors**

Overview: A buddy system for pupils who are new to Glebe to be supported by another service family pupil who have been at the school for a while

Aim/Outcomes: Children settle into life at Glebe quickly and are 'shown the ropes' by children who have made the same transition.

**Cost of Training Mentors: £245.50** 

# Parental Engagement

#### **Coffee Mornings/Afternoon**

Overview: Families of service children are invited to regular coffee mornings or afternoons to meet with key staff and other service families.

Aim/Outcomes: Families have the opportunity to meet with other families and those new to Glebe can obtain information and be supported in accessing local services.

Cost of refreshments: approx. £50 per year

## Full Time Pastoral Support Worker & Service Family Support Worker

Overview: Our Pastoral Support Worker and Service Family Support Worker are available to meet with parents at the beginning and end of the school day or by telephone contact.

Aim/Outcomes: Families have the opportunity to discuss any worries or concerns they have with them so they can support them as well as their child/ren.

## Academic

#### **Catch Up Sessions**

Overview: Regular Interventions for pupils who have missed out on being taught certain concepts or topics due to mobility.

Aim/Outcomes: Service children are not disadvantaged academically due to being a service child. Pupils feel confident and gaps in their learning are closed.

Cost: £1,789.20

### Celebration/Promotion

#### Camo Day/Red White and Blue Day/Remembrance

Overview: On alternate years we raise money for SSAFA through Camo Day and Red, White and Blue Day. This also serves to raise the profile of our military families.

Aim/Outcomes: To promote the culture and context of service children within the school.
