Glebe Primary School Breakfast Club



Information for parents wishing to use our Breakfast Club services

Breakfast club is available for children in Reception through to Year 6. We have a pre-booking policy and request that all parents wanting to book a place for their child do so in ample time. We are only able to take 60 children per day and cannot accept any children over this number or on an ad hoc basis.

Time

7.45 am - 8.40 am Children are welcome any time from 7.45 onwards but if they require breakfast please can we ask that they arrive no later than 8.15

Breakfast club takes place in the hut at the far end of the playground and access is through the gate adjacent to the car park. A member of staff will be at the gate from 7.45 until 8 am. If you arrive after this time the gate will be closed and a member of staff will let you in when you arrive.



<u>Cost</u>

£4.50 a session. Bookings to be made via "IRIS ParentMail" only. Pre-booking is essential to secure your place due to our recent increase in numbers.

<u>Breakfast</u>

We offer a varied menu including a variety of cereals, porridge and toast. There is a choice of fruit juice, water or milk to drink. Fresh fruit will also be available.

We offer a special option twice a week. This will include one of the following: vegetarian sausages, beans, scrambled eggs, bagels, pancakes or croissants.

Please inform a member of staff if your child has any dietary requirements or you would rather your child avoid choosing a particular item from our breakfast club menu.

You are also more than welcome to provide us with your own choice of breakfast cereal for your child if you would prefer.

Once the children have eaten breakfast they are able to choose from a range of activities including board games, colouring, reading and puzzles.

We also offer the children the opportunity to play outside every morning as long as the weather allows us to.

Children are dismissed at 8.40 am, when school opens, so that they can then make their way to their classrooms. Reception children are escorted to their class by a member of staff.
