Ofsted Report and KS2 SATS Results Published

It has been a very busy week here at Glebe! The report from Ofsted following our recent inspection has been finalised and is attached to this newsletter and is available on our website. We are a little disappointed not to have improved on our grading, especially since we have made so much progress since our last inspection. However, since the last inspection, the Ofsted framework has changed and the grading for Good is much harder to attain and even the lead inspector was keen to stress that achieving an Outstanding grading is extremely difficult now. The report doesn't fully reflect the positive verbal feedback we were given during the two days, or the practice they saw and generally feels quite impersonal. That said, we take onboard the areas to improve and the staff and I will work hard to address them over the next 4 years. I feel so proud of our staff and our pupils as we couldn't have done more to showcase what we are about as a school.

This is reflected in our KS2 SATS results this year which demonstrate the quality of the education the children get at Glebe.

I can confirm that the online school permit application system for next year has just gone live. We have attached a guide for parents/carers on how to make an online application.

Due to the delay in the application system going live, we will not be able to process and approve applications now until early September. You can still apply online and complete the information to help us process your application, but we cannot approve them until after the holidays.

Please don't forget that the criterion is distance of the child's residence that we have registered on our system to Glebe school. Due to high demand, if you live within a 2 mile radius of the school, you will not be allocated a permit.

So we are able to process and approve the applications once they are uploaded, please complete the slip on the attached letter, giving us your details so we can process and approve all applications that meet the criterion once we return in September.

Please note: you must have applied online <u>and</u> have returned the completed form to school by the deadline in order for your application to be considered.

The deadline for submitting the slip for processing is **Wednesday 19th July**. This can either be handed into school office or emailed to the office@glebeprimary.org account.

We are aiming to approve all applications that meet the criterion on Tuesday 5th September.

In the unlikely event that the permits are not allocated before the start of the new school year, all parents/carers dropping off or collecting are given a 5 minute 'grace' window by parking enforcement as long as they are parked legally and with all 4 wheels within the white lines of the parking bay.






Breakfast Club
