

Summary of School Data – Updated November 2015

This is a summary of the key school data for 2015. Information for the previous 3 years can also be found on this page of the website. You may also wish to look at the DFE School League Tables (link also on this page) to consider comparisons with other schools.

EYFS – 63% of pupils made a good level of development compared to the national average of 61% and our school level of 62% in 2014.

Year 1 Phonics – 79% of pupils met the expected level compared to 85% last year and 77% nationally.

Year 2 Phonics – 11 pupils had to do the test again as a result of not meeting the expectation last year or having not completed the test at their previous school. Of these 5 (45%) passed compared to 73% last year and 66% nationally. In total 90% of children had met the expectation for phonics development by the end of Year 2 which is exactly in line with national averages.
