I hope you have all had a good week.

Phonics Screening Check Results

As the pass mark has now been confirmed, I am delighted to report that **94%** of the children in year 1 passed the check. **44%** of these children scored full marks!

Multiplication Tables Check Results

The results have been released and I am pleased to report that **76%** of the pupils in Year 4 scored 20 or more out of 25 in the test. With **40%** achieving full marks.

The national averages have yet to be released for either of these assessments so we cannot compare our performance against them. However, I will publish the comparison data once I have it. For context though, last year's national average for the Phonics was 79% and the MTC was 29% achieving full marks.
