# Pupil Premium

## What is Pupil Premium?

Did you know that registering for Pupil Premium means that your child's school could get extra money?

Pupil Premium is additional funding that the Government provides to help children from low income families. The Pupil Premium Grant must be spent to help eligible pupils reach their full potential, both academically and socially, and the school will decide how best to spend this.

## How much is the Pupil Premium?

Schools will receive £1,385 for eligible primary-aged pupils. We put this towards 1:1 tuition for the eligible pupils, we provide new uniform items twice a year and pupils have access to homework club as well as subsidising the cost of school trips for these children.

## Who is eligible for Pupil Premium?

Pupil premium is allocated to pupils from low income families who meet the eligibility check.

Qualifying benefits are as follows:

- Income Support
- Jobseeker's Allowance (income-based)
- Employment and Support Allowance (income-based)
- Child Tax Credit based on income below £16,190
- The Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Asylum Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Working Tax Credit 'run on' (this is the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Families who receive any level of Working Tax Credit are not entitled to Pupil Premium.



# Pupil Premium

Even though all pupils now receive access to free school meals through Government and Mayoral funding, this does not mean that any child automatically qualifies for the Pupil Premium and parents must still apply.

## How do I apply for Pupil Premium?

If you think you may be entitled to Pupil Premium, Ms Varney can check eligibility via a secure portal. Please contact her via the school office.

There are also Premiums available to children of Forces Families and Looked After Children. Please let us know if this may apply to your child.

## Penalty Notice Fines for School Attendance are Changing

With the introduction of the new National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19th August 2024.

### Per Parent, Per Child

Penalty Notice Fines will now be issued to each parent, for each child that was absent.

For Example: 3 siblings absent for term time leave would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

### 5 Consecutive days of Term Time Leave

Penalty notice fines will be issued for Term Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

### 10 Sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10- week period

Penalty notice fines will be considered when there has been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a 10 week period.

### First Offence

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be :

£160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days.

Reduced to £80 per parent per child if paid within 21 days

### Second Offence

#### (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days

### Third Offence and Any Further Offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrate's court. Magistrates fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child.

Cases found guilty in Magistrates court can show on the parent's future DBS certificate, due to failure to safeguard a child's education.

### Local Authority DO NOT accept the following as exceptional circumstances:

- My work do not allow me to take holidays during the school summer holiday period, even if they provide a letter
- My child needs a holiday at quieter times due to needs
- Our holiday has been gifted and paid for and did not have a choice of dates
- My child has good or 100% attendance
- I will report my child being poorly - schools are expected to carry out home visits, if a holiday is suspected, school will report to the local authority for a penalty notice fine
