- Maintain the correct tense (including present perfect tense) throughout a piece of writing.
- Use a full range of punctuation from previous year-groups including inverted commas and commas to punctuate lists correctly
- Use varied vocabulary.
- Use conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to show time, place and cause.
- Join letters correctly.
- Use headings and sub-headings in instructional writing.
