



Literacy

Comprehension: We will read the Iron Man by Ted Hughes and focus on characterisation, making predictions and developing grammar knowledge.

Grammar and Spelling: Children will reinforce their understanding of commas and apostrophes. Spelling rules will focus on prefixes and suffixes.

Writing:

Poetry - This term children read and respond to a range of poems and prose extracts that use similes and other simple images to create a vivid picture for a reader.

News Reports - In the latter half of the term children will be exploring newspaper/ journalistic writing and explanation texts.

PSHE

New beginnings; getting on and falling out; saying no to bullying.

History/Geography

We will be learning about Roman Britain, including the invasion, Roman soldiers and lifestyle similarities and differences.

RE

This term we are studying Hinduism. Ultimately children will understand that there are many different gods, worshipped in a variety of ways.

PE

Invasion games including netball and hockey. Learning a number of skills - passing and game tactics.

Circuit Training - learning fitness skills during circuit training.

ICT

Learning how to write algorithms to code a simple game.

Music

Looking at creating basic rhythms using crotchets and quavers. Composition.

Place Value

Looking at place value of numbers to 10,000. Compare and order positive and negative numbers. Develop written methods for addition and subtraction. Multiplying whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication and Division:

Written methods of the 4 operations up to 4 digits. Securing mental methods of multiplication and practical division.

Measures:

Problem solving using measuring. Beginning to convert units of length. Working on time using the digital and analogue format. Estimating and reading scales.


Science
