Friday 22nd January


We have had a lovely week continuing to learn all about Nursery Rhymes. This week we have been learning all about Jack and Jill, designing our own buckets, making our own Jack and Jill's and investigating if it is possible to fill a bucket using a sieve.....the children came up with a few ideas from putting our hands underneath the sieve to putting paper in the bottom. We also learnt about Baa Baa Black sheep, we did lots of sheep craft, sheep counting and built a fence to keep the sheep in the field.

Next week we will be learning some Number Rhymes and reading books with numbers in them. We will be reading '10 Little Ladybirds', '10 Little Tadpoles' and a few others. If you have any number rhyme books or stories with numbers your child would like to show the rest of the class please feel free to send them in for us to read.

Next week 'Stay and Play' will be on Tuesday 26th January from 8.45am - 9.15am and 12.30pm - 1.00pm. We would love to see you, so if you are available please come along.



We will also be learning about size and using size related language and we will be counting up to 10 and also learning how to form the numbers 1-10 correctly.



Next week is the last chance for your child to complete our nursery rhyme challenge so please keep practicing singing nursery rhymes with your child over the weekend, certificates will be given to those children who recite eight nursery rhymes.
