

Letters and Sounds is a phonics resource published by the Department for Education and Skills. It aims to build children's speaking and listening skills in their own right. Letter and sounds sets out to prepare children for learning to read by developing their phonic knowledge and skills. The detailed and systematic programme for teaching phonic skills is from Nursery to Year 2.

Letters and Sound included 6 Phases which overlap, the table below shows the coverage of each phase.

At Glebe we introduce phonics through a fun and child centred approach called Jolly Phonics. We believe it to be a great way of motivating children to learn the skills to read and write. The programme is multi-sensory and includes 42 letter action and a variety of interactive games.
